

The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) has been enacted by the Parliament and has come into force from 15 June, 2005. This Act provides for right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds

provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act. Full text of the act is available on the website <https://rti.gov.in/>

Citizens can seek information regarding the activities of Govt. College Barwala, Hisar by submitting a written request with details like Name, address, contact telephone number and particulars of the information sought. The reason for seeking information need not be given.

If the reply is not received in time or if the information is not given, you can tender appeal to the First

Appellate Authority, Government College Barwala, Hisar. In time or if the information is not given, you can tender appeal to the First Appellate Authority, Government College Barwala, Hisar.
