Health Facilities

1. On-Campus Health Facilities

Currently, the college does not appear to have a fully dedicated medical center or permanent doctor on campus. The health-related services are primarily activity-based or basic:

First Aid: Basic first aid is generally available in the administrative block and science laboratories (Chemistry/Physics labs) for immediate minor injuries.

Clean Drinking Water: The college provides RO (Reverse Osmosis) clean cold water to ensure student health and hygiene.

Sanitation: The campus maintains a "Clean and Green" environment with standard washroom facilities, though student reviews on maintenance are mixed.

2. Health Awareness & Camps (NSS)

The college's National Service Scheme (NSS) unit is the primary driver of health services on campus. They regularly organize:

Blood Donation Camps: Organized annually or bi-annually to promote public health awareness.

Cleanliness Drives: Regular campus cleaning activities to prevent disease.

3. Nearby Medical Support (External)

For serious medical issues, the college relies on government healthcare facilities located in the immediate vicinity of Barwala:

Community Health Center (CHC), Barwala: This is the primary government hospital serving the area.
